Lineage & Honors

Constituted 8 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 41st Signal Construction Battalion and activated 25 January 1943 at Camp Forrest, Tennessee. Reorganized and re-designated 14 May 1945 as the 41st Signal Light Construction Battalion. Inactivated 7 December 1945 in Germany. Re-designated 20 October 1950 as the 41st Signal Construction Battalion and allotted to the Regular Army. Activated 13 November 1950 at Camp Rucker, Alabama. Re-designated 20 October 1953 as the 41st Signal Battalion (Construction). Inactivated: Companies A, B, C and D inactivated 1 March 1970 at Qui Nhon, Vietnam and Headquarters and Headquarters Company 27 February 1972 at Fort Lewis, Washington. (Headquarters and Headquarters Company activated 1 July 1974 at Yongsan, Korea).
