MEMORANDUM FOR ALL WIGHTMAN NCO ACADEMY ASSIGNED SOLDIERS

SUBJECT: Commandant's Policy #4, Food/Alcohol Consumption

1. Policies:

a. It is important and imperative a professional standard and example for our students. As such Camp Jackson is a small installation and requires us to ensure we limit some activities when students are around. Some areas must be restricted to ensure the proper standard and examples are set. The areas on the installation authorized for outside consumption of food and alcohol are:

(1) Patio outside of Stripes NCO Club. Patio area is defined: From stairs leading up to the club and around to the back door of club. This belongs to the cadre **only** after 1800 daily. No students belong near the Stripes Club after 1800. Alcohol may be consumed out on the patio area. No alcohol will leave this area. Using the Stripes NCO Club patio area to cook food is allowed.

(2) The break area directly behind the cadre barracks. This area is limited to the picnic area on the northwestern corner of the cadre barracks. Alcohol is authorized to be consumed in this location. Cadre must take caution not to leave this area with alcohol in hand walking anywhere except cadre barracks.

b. Anyone wishing to use another area must have approval from Commandant, Deputy Commandant or 1SG.

c. Food that is served in the dining facility is consumed there, your quarters, or one of the authorized patio areas.

d. You will not walk around the installation with lit cigarettes or open containers. Instructors will not smoke in front of or in the company of students. Instructors do not bring open containers of coffee, juice, sports drinks, soda bottles or cans, or any other beverage other than water in a canteen to training.


e. When both KTA and WLC are not in session these policy will not apply except paragraph

d. which will remain in effect.
