NUMERICAL DESIGNATIONS OF REPUBLIC OF KOREA AIRFIELDS AND HELIPORTS

SUPPLEMENTATION. Issue of further supplements to this regulation by subordinate commands is prohibited unless prior approval is obtained from HQ USFK, ATTN: EACJ-EA, Unit #15237, APO AP 96205-0010.

1. **PURPOSE.** This regulation prescribes procedures for requesting designations of new heliports and airfields within the Republic of Korea.

2. **APPLICABILITY.** This regulation applies to Headquarters, United States Forces, Korea, and major subordinate commands which are under the operational control of Headquarters, United States Forces, Korea.

3. **REFERENCES.** Required publication. AR 380-5 (Department of the Army Information Security Program). Cited in subparagraph 4a(4).

4. **RESPONSIBILITIES.**

a. The commanding officer of the unit controlling the facility will be responsible for--

(1) Requesting the numerical designation from the ACofS, J3, ATTN: EACJ-EA, Unit #15237, APO AP 96205-0010.

(2) Maintaining the facility in a fully operational state.

(3) Notifying the ACofS, J3, EUSA Aviation Office, ATTN: EACJ-EA-ATC, Unit #15237, APO AP 96205-0010, in the event the facility becomes non-operational.

(4) Forwarding requests for airfield/heliport reclassification or numerical designation to the ACofS, J3, ATTN: EACJ-EA, Unit #15237, APO AP 96205-0010. In the event it becomes necessary to list the unit located at the facility, this information will be classified in accordance with AR 380-5. Requests will contain facility information using airfield and heliport legends of the Department of Defense flight information publication (enroute) supplement as a guide. All requests will contain the following information:

- (a) Location (by UTM grid 6-digit coordinates and latitude-longitude).
 - (b) Elevation (mean sea level in feet).
 - (c) Dimensions of runway or pad.
 - (d) Type of surface.
 - (e) Lighting facilities available.
 - (f) Type of fuel available.
 - (g) Type of service available.
 - (h) Aerodrome/heliport remarks to include any hazards to safe flight operations, the presence of wind/indicators, and any other pertinent information, such as emergency use only status, or prior notice required for landing.
 - (i) Radio/navigational remarks to include radio frequencies and hours of tower operation.
- b. ~~The Eighth United States Army Aviation Officer is responsible for--~~
- (1) Evaluating requests for airfield and heliport designation.
 - (2) Assigning and publishing numerical designations.
 - (3) Evaluating each request and arranging for an on-site inspection of the facility. The inspection results will be furnished to the requesting unit commander.
 - (4) Ensuring that information on all newly designated facilities is submitted to the United States Army Air Traffic Control Activity Aeronautical Services Office for publishing in the Department of Defense flight information publication.
 - (5) Ensuring that coordination is effected with the approach control agencies and the air route traffic control center before establishment of new heliports/airfields or a significant increase in air activity at an established location.

5. AIRFIELDS/HELIPORTS.

- a. Each permanent airfield or heliport will be assigned a one-letter prefix and a 3-digit numeral.
- b. One of the following prefixes will be appropriately assigned to each facility:

- (1) A - United States Army airfield.
- (2) E - Emergency use only airfield.
- (3) H - United States Army heliport.


c. The 3-digit numeral will be assigned consecutively (that is, 100, 101, 102) according to the area in which the facility is located. No numeral will be utilized more than once. Areas of numerical designation are shown in appendix A.

The proponent of this regulation is the Office of the ACoFS, J3. Users are invited to send comments and suggested improvements on DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) to the Commander, USFK, ATTN: EACJ-EA, Unit #15237, APO AP 96205-0010.


