Water and Messing – Capability to provide food service support to resident and transient population. Production/delivery/procurement of both potable and non-potable water.</li> <li>e. Health Readiness – Integrated Base/Area medical support and patient care to include inpatient, outpatient, dental services, and medical waste disposal/incineration.</li> <li>f.
