## **Deployment Reminders**

### **Billets**

While in billets, cell phone ringers should be shut off.

All Butler buildings' lights will be turned on daily only during hours notified on the doors. Building Mayors will enforce light schedule. Use a flashlight whenever possible.

For the benefit of all, personal items should be locked up when unattended.

### **CP Oscar Access**

- Security badges must be visible at all times.
- Turn in all temporary badges.
- Escorted personnel require supervision at all times.

### **Uniform**

BDUs, boots, ballistic helmets, protective mask and LBV/LCE are required. Soft cap will not be worn with LBE/LCE and mask. Black backpacks are not authorized with BDUs while on deployment. Sleeves will be rolled down and subdued rank on soft cap for all exercise participants.

Army PT uniforms are required during normal PT hours only. Reflective vest for all outdoor PT-related activities.

Uniform in MWR facilities is BDUs.

### **Security**

Classified document security is the responsibility of each section. Sections should destroy classified material as it becomes obsolete. Also, individuals should avoid discussing exercise issues outside the controlled areas.

Location of the CP, the duration and scope of the exercise cannot be discussed over open telephone lines.

### ***No alcohol during exercise***

***Alcohol consumption by exercise personnel is prohibited in accordance with U.S.F.K. Regulation 27-5.***

***Consumption of alcohol during the exercise is a punishable offense, and individuals who violate this regulation may be subject to non-judicial punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.***

### **No golf course shortcuts**

Personnel are prohibited from taking shortcuts across the golf course.

### **Exercise Rules**

There are no off-post privileges during the period of the exercise. Also, housing area and barracks are off limits unless you are an invited guest.

## Camp Walker is named after...

Lt. Gen. Walton H. Walker, former 8th U.S. Army commander, was a highly decorated veteran of World War I and World War II, who performed admirably during the Korean War. His defense of the Nakdong Line during the Korean War is regarded as a military classic. He was the commander of the 8th U.S. Army in Korea when he was killed in a jeep wreck near Seoul on Dec. 23, 1950.
